## Elections in Ireland on 17 February 1987

In accordance with normal practice for officiais of the European Communities when an election is held in their country of origin, special leave and travelling time may be granted to officials and agents of the Commission qualified to vote in person.

Travelling time for elections is calculated *in* working days, which may be used before, after or partly before and the rest after election day. The 17 february falls on a working day and is not counted as part of the travelling time.

Travelling time is calculated as follows :

distance between place of work and place of election

between	50	and	250	kms	0,5	day	+	voting day
	251	and	600	kms	1,0	day	+	voting day
	601	and	900	kms	1,5	days	+	voting day
	901	and	1400	kms	2,0	days	+	voting day
	1401	and	2000	kms	2,5	days	+	votingday
	over	2000	kms		3,0	days	+	voting day

Travelling time and special leave shall be granted only on production of appropriate travel documents and documentary evidence of having voted.

Officials and other servants of Ireland who are unable to obtain this documents are requested to submit their ticket of travel from the place of work to the place of voting, accompanied by a formal statement by the person concerned, certifying that he has voted.
