- 2 Core Staff Only items are accessible to the set of officials and other staff of the Commission in active employment in the sense of Article 36 of the Staff Regulations.
- 3 NET1 login vs CUD login. The first allows a workstation to become part of the domain NET1. The second determines the set of services that a particular user is authorized to access. E.g. As of today, the internal power-on login is for NET1, while the "Internet" login is checked against the CUD
- 4 See table below concerning access facilitation
- 5 "Y" if user's login authorized to access by information owner. "N" otherwise
- 6 "Y" if user's workstation is included in the domain's access list. "N" otherwise

Who facilitates access to IntraComm

Beneficiary Group	Managing service
EC Active Staff	The <i>Human Resources</i> unit of each DG manages the registration of Active Staff in the Central User Directory
EC Staff on leave and secondment	Officials seconded in the interest of the service and officials on leave (maternity, parental, or family leave) are managed by the <i>Human Resources</i> unit of their DG of origin. Officials seconded at own request are managed by: <i>ADMIN/A/4</i> in Brussels (all except Lux & JRC staff), <i>ADMIN/A/4.LUX</i> (Only Luxembourg staff) and <i>JRC Human Resources</i> (Only JRC staff)
Other EU Institutions staff	They are <i>not managed by the Commission services</i> . They are supported by their own ICT organization who, when necessary, will contact the Central HelpDesk of the Commission. There are no other-EU-staff registrations in the Central User Directory of the Commission.
Retired / Invalid EC staff	Managed by <i>ADMIN/C/1</i> + voluntary support from <i>A/ACE helpdesk</i>
EU staff on CCP & military service	<i>ADMIN/A/4</i> in Brussels (all except Lux & JRC staff), <i>ADMIN/A/4.LUX</i> (Only Luxembourg staff) and <i>JRC Human Resources</i> (Only JRC staff)
Generic logins	Managed by the <i>requesting official</i> , to whom the Access Control Office delivers the generic login
In-house Contractors	Managed by the <i>contracting unit</i>
IntraComm via Token generator	This type of access is subject to a <i>security convention</i> co-signed by DS, DIGIT, the contracting unit and the contractor
